This guide provides a brief synopsis of each Book included in the Books Library.

1. **An Annotated Guide to the UAE Labour Law: Shiraz Sethi (Dentons), Thenji Moyo (Gateley) and Ali Al Assaad (Dentons)**

This title includes the full-text of the Federal Law No. 8 of 1980 on Regulation of Labour Relations with in-line annotations and insights by the author team.

2. **An Annotated Guide to Dubai Real Estate Law: Jeremy Scott (Addleshaw Goddard)**

A reproduction of the text of the principal real estate laws, together with practical annotations and authored insights, including Dubai Law No. 8 of 2007, concerning guarantee accounts of real estate development, and Dubai Law No. 13 of 2008, which regulates initial property registration in the Emirate of Dubai. The Annotated Guide also reproduces two other related and relevant instruments: Dubai Law No. 9 of 2009 and Dubai Res Cab No. 6 of 2010.

3. **Annotated Guide to UAE Arbitration Chapter, Gordon Blanke and Sally Kotb, 2013**

A commentary on the UAE Arbitration Chapter, which comprises Articles 203 to 218, and Articles 235 to 238 of UAE Civil Procedures Code. Commentary is provided on each of these Articles, setting out their proper construction by reference to the prevailing case law of the UAE Courts, including the UAE Courts of Cassation.

4. **Blanke on UAE Arbitration Legislation and Rules, Dr. Gordon Blanke, Volume I, 2nd Edition**

This Volume focuses on the UAE's onshore arbitration legislation. The work is divided into a total of three parts. Part I provides a general introduction to arbitration in the UAE. Part II provides updated article-by-article commentary on the former UAE Arbitration Chapter that formed the core of the first edition of this work. Part III provides an article-by-article commentary of the provision of the 2018 UAE Federal Arbitration Law and Council Decision No. 57/2018, which establishes a new, expedited regime for the recognition and enforcement of foreign arbitral awards in the UAE.

5. **A Legal Guide to Doing Business in Saudi Arabia, Amgad Hussein and John Balouziyeh, 2013**

The book provides an overview of laws, such as tax and privacy regulations applicable to all companies, and it concludes with a discussion of arbitration, litigation, and other forms of dispute resolution available in Saudi Arabia.

It provides an overview of the laws relevant to conducting business investment and operations in Kuwait and Qatar. This title covers incorporation rules, taxation, employment, environmental law, intellectual property, and E-commerce.

It provides an expert interpretation and commentary of the Civil Code, considering commentary from the Ministry of Justice and the Federal and Dubai Courts of Cassation. It includes contract law, plus drafting and interpretation of an agreement, party responsibility, effects of fraud and mistake, and liberty to withdraw and remedies for breach. The commentary is adapted to several types of transactions such as sales, leases, agency, and bailment.
