



### TIP: How to request Arabic to English translation of legislation

This tip will explain how to request the translation of legislation on the Westlaw International - Middle East platform.

1. When accessing legislation on the Westlaw International - Middle East platform, the translation status may reflect as “**translated by request**”, with the Arabic version of the law uploaded in PDF format.
2. Click on the “**translated by request**” hyperlink. This will create a pre-populated email to request the translation. This is a complimentary service as part of your subscription.
